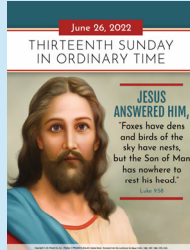
### DISCIPLESHIP'S COSTS

In today's first reading, God tells the prophet Elijah to prepare Elisha to succeed him. Succeeding Elijah will be no easy task; he has spent his life facing threats from the kings he has confronted about their infidelity to the God of Israel. The psalm illustrates the emotional and spiritual distress that the prophets' steadfast faithfulness to God brought them. Paul's description of the Christian's freedom from the law as opposed to "the desire of the flesh" puts this struggle at the very heart of Christian identity. The reading from Luke's Gospel recounts Jesus' decision to journey toward Jerusalem, where he knows he will meet his earthly fate. Following Jesus—like succeeding Elijah as prophet—will now become more difficult. Unlike his calls to the first disciples, Jesus encounters those who are not ready or are not strong enough to journey with him.—Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

As Independence Day draws near, we think of the men and women of the military who serve with courage and competence, some far from home. How does the Church accompany them? In 1939, Pope Pius XII created an independent jurisdiction of the Catholic Church called the "Military Vicariate." In 1985 Pope John Paul II created the "Archdiocese for Military Services, USA." Spanning the globe and serving nearly one and a half million Roman Catholics, more than one thousand priests minister in hospitals, on military bases of all the armed forces, on ships at sea, and on the battlefield. The AMS does not ordain priests, but accepts priests on loan from religious orders and dioceses. In 1824 a Jesuit priest named Adam Marshall enlisted in the Navy and died at sea in 1825. He was assigned as a "schoolmaster," but he sought out and ministered to Catholic sailors. Twenty years later, President Polk was worried that the war with Mexico was seen as anti-Catholic, so he recruited two Jesuit priests to serve in the army as chaplains. At the time of the Civil War, only about ten percent of Americans were Catholic. Military policies forced Catholic soldiers to attend Protestant services. The Church protested this rule, and many priests volunteered to become chaplains. Their witness and the courage of the "Nuns of the Battlefield" (several orders of sisters who assisted Civil War victims) helped temper prejudice against Catholics and pave the way for the life and ministry of this vigorous and unique archdiocese.

## El Decimotercer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario 26 de Junio del 2022

### EL VALOR DEL DISCIPULADO

En la primera lectura de hoy, Dios le dice al profeta Elías que prepare a Eliseo para que sea su sucesor. Ser sucesor de Elías no será una tarea fácil, él ha pasado su vida enfrentado las amenazas de los reyes a los que ha confrontado por sus infidelidades al Dios de Israel. El salmo ilustra la angustia emocional y espiritual que la firme fidelidad de los profetas a Dios les produjo. La descripción de Pablo de la libertad del cristiano frente a la ley en contraposición al “deseo de la carne” pone esta lucha en el corazón mismo de la identidad cristiana. La lectura del Evangelio de Lucas relata la decisión de Jesús de viajar a Jerusalén, donde él sabe que encontrará su destino terrenal. Seguir a Jesús, así como suceder a Elías como profeta, será menos fácil. A diferencia de sus llamadas a los primeros discípulos, Jesús se encuentra con aquellos que no están preparados o no son lo suficientemente fuertes para viajar con él.—Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.



### TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

El último sábado de junio o el primero de julio en un ayuntamiento de Valcildacos, España, se pone en escena el Miserere escrito por Gustavo Adolfo Bécquer (1836-1870). Esta obra relata como un músico llega de noche a la Abadía de Fetero pidiendo posada. Los hermanos del monasterio lo invitaron a pasar la noche. Allí él les contó su vida pecaminosa y su deseo de encontrar un Miserere (Salmo 51) digno de expiar sus pecados ante Dios. Le contaron del Miserere del Monte que cantaban durante la noche los monjes difuntos de un Monasterio que había sido destruido siglos atrás. El músico afanado por encontrar su Miserere, corrió a la montaña donde escuchó aquel lamento y bello canto. Al regresar a la Abadía intentó escribir la música de aquel Miserere, pero lo único que logró fue volverse loco. Aquel pobre hombre murió sin reconocer que cada quien debe entonar a su manera su propio y pobre Miserere mei (piedad de mi).
